Language requirements

Programs taught in English (except summer sessions) : B2 (TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS). If the student does not have one of the above certificates, we can accept an official written letter from the home university attesting that the student's level in English is sufficient to study academic courses.

Programs taught in French : B2 (TCF, ETEF, DELF).

Health & Insurance

Students are required to provide a copy of their International Health Insurance Certificate (covering repatriation, civil liability and extra medical costs) as well as:

EU-residents : a valid copy of your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)

Non-EU residents : a certificate proving that you applied for the French Health Scheme (Sécurité Sociale). It is mandatory and free.
